

CHAPTER 312.

AN ACT to provide for the payment of mileage to witnesses summoned to the circuit court for Garrett county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That witnesses in Garrett county who shall reside more than three miles from the place of holding the circuit court, shall in addition to the per diem allowed by law receive six and one-quarter cents per mile for every mile exceeding the first three, to be allowed in going to the court, but no witness shall be allowed mileage more than once going to said court in any one term. Mileage.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

CHAPTER 313.

AN ACT to provide that section one, of article fifty-six, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Licenses," sub-title "Mode of issuing, general provisions," shall apply to Garrett county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the provisions of section one, of article fifty-six, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Licenses," sub-title "Mode of issuing, general provisions," shall apply to Garrett county as fully as if the said section in its terms, words and language was herein contained and repealed and made to have full force and effect in said Garrett county. Licenses.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

CHAPTER 314.
