

this act, and bring the said person or persons before a justice of the peace in said county to be dealt with as herein provided.

Fines. SEC. 5. *And be it enacted,* That all fines accruing from the enforcement of this act shall be paid one-half to the informer in each and every case, and one-half to the secretary and treasurer of the school board of Somerset county for the use of the public schools of said county.

Effective. SEC. 6. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 354.

AN ACT to enable the general convention of universalists to hold property in the State of Maryland for religious purposes.

To authorize. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the universalist general convention, a chartered corporation holding property in various States of the United States, be authorized in the State of Maryland to receive for religious purposes by deed or bequest any property, and hold and convey the same; and any religious organization now existing or which may hereafter exist within the State of Maryland is hereby authorized to convey to the general convention aforesaid any property now held or which may hereafter be acquired by them, any laws to the contrary notwithstanding.

Effective. SEC. 2. *Be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 355.

AN ACT to repeal sections one hundred and sixty-five and one hundred and sixty-six, of article seventeen, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Prince George's county," sub-title "Hyattsville," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Effective. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That sections one hundred and sixty-five and one hundred and sixty-six, of article seventeen, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Prince George's county," sub-title "Hyattsville," be and the same are hereby repealed, and thereupon re-enacted to read as follows:
