office, and that he be required to make an index of said estates so enclosed in boxes and numbered, as well as of the guardianship accounts and papers for ready reference.

SEC. 2. Be it enacted. That the county commissioners of Queen Anne's county, Maryland, are required to levy on the assessable property of said county, a sum sufficient to pay the said register Levy. of wills two cents per document and five cents for each index required by the foregoing section, as also for the necessary costs of boxes or envelopes.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted. That this act shall take effect from Effective. the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 360.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money for the purpose of furnishing and carpeting the State library annex.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sum of twelve hundred dollars or so much thereof as Appropri- may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State treasury not otherwise appropriated for the purpose of furnishing and carpeting the State library annex to be expended under the direction and supervision of the State librarian.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the treasurer of the State on the warrant of the comptroller, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to disburse said sum of money hereby appropriated for the objects and purposes herein specified, to or upon the order of the person or persons certified by the State librarian to be entitled to receive the same.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from Effective. the date of its passage.
