pany to heat passenger cars with stoves, be and the same is hereby extended to July first, eighteen hundred and ninety-one; and if Carstoves. by the last mentioned date satisfactory evidence shall be furnished to the board of public works of Maryland, that no reasonably safe and practicable substitute for stoves as a means of heating said cars has been found, then said board of public works may extend the time during which stoves may be used on said cars until May first, eighteen hundred and ninety-two.

## CHAPTER 378.

AN ACT to repeal section one hundred and ninety-three, of article two, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel county," sub-title "Roads," and re-enact the same with amendments.

To repeal

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section one hundred and ninety-three, of article two, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel county," subtitle "Roads," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, so as to read as follows:

Bridges.

SEC. 193. Nothing in the preceding section shall in any way relate to or affect the construction of the public bridges of said county, if the cost of the construction of the same exceeds the sum of five hundred dollars, but all other public bridges shall be considered as parts of the public roads in the election districts in which they are respectively located.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
