CHAPTER 381.

AN ACT to add a new section to article twenty-four, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Worcester county," sub-title "Liquors and intoxicating drinks," to follow section one hundred and thirty-five, and to be known as "Section one hundred and thirty-five A."

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, To add. That a new section be added to article twenty-four, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Worcester county," sub-title "Liquors and intoxicating drinks," to follow section one hundred and thirty-five, and to be known as "Section one hundred and thirty-five A."

135 A. Be it enacted, That any freeholder who does not own in his or her own right real estate of the assessed value of one hundred and fifty dollars clear of incumbrances shall not be eligible Not eng or competent to sign any certificate, recommendation or other paper relating to the application of any person or persons for a license to sell liquor or intoxicating drinks within the limits of school district number three, of election district number four of Worcester county.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect on and from the first day of May, eighteen hundred and ninety.

CHAPTER 382.

AN ACT to provide for deferring the advertisement and sale of real estate in Prince George's county in default of payment of taxes levied in the month of March, eighteen hundred and ninety.

Whereas, section one hundred and sixteen B, of article seven-Preamble, teen, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Prince George's county," sub-title "County Treasurer," approved on the twenty-first day of March, eighteen hundred and ninety, requires the county treasurer of that county on the second Monday of January in each year, to make up and publish a list of all taxes in default
