

A justice. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That in addition to the two justices of the peace in the first election district of Kent county as now provided by law, there shall be an additional justice of the peace appointed for said district in Kent county, and the governor is hereby authorized to appoint and commission an additional justice of the peace for said district.

Constable. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That in addition to the two constables in the first election district of Kent county as now provided by law, there shall be an additional constable appointed for said district in Kent county, and the county commissioners of said county are hereby authorized to appoint and commission an additional constable for said district.

Effective SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 57.

AN ACT to repeal section one hundred and seven, of article two, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel county," sub-title "Circuit Court," and re-enact the same with amendments.

Repeal. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section one hundred and seven, of article two, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel county," sub-title "Circuit Court," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:

Term. SEC. 107. There shall be two regular common law terms of the circuit court for Anne Arundel county, at the city of Annapolis, commencing respectively on the third Monday in April and the third Monday in October in each year.

Effective. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claim of Messrs. Thomas & Evans, printers and publishers of Baltimore city, for printing the State school report for the year of eighteen hundred and eighty-eight.
