

serve without pay, and a majority of them shall be a quorum for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this act.

Appropriation. SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That for the purpose of defraying the expense of procuring and erecting a monument over the grave of the said Leonard Calvert, as aforesaid, the sum of two thousand dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated, and the comptroller is hereby directed to draw his warrant upon the treasurer of Maryland, payable to the said committee, for said purposes.

Effective. SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 420.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments section eighteen, of article fifty-six, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Licenses," sub-title "Brokers."

Repeal SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section eighteen, of article fifty-six, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Licenses," sub-title "Brokers," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:

License. 18. Any person or partnership applying for the same and paying the sum of eighteen dollars and seventy-five cents for each individual or representative of such firm or partnership, may obtain a license for carrying on the business of a grain broker, coffee broker, cotton broker or sugar broker in the city of Baltimore.

Repeal. SEC. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

Effective. SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 422.

AN ACT to repeal section one hundred and fifteen, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Talbot county, so far as the same relates to the catching of fish with pound-nets, fyke-nets and weirs in the waters of Miles, Tred Avon and Wye rivers.
