

## CHAPTER 429.

AN ACT to add an additional section to article twenty-seven, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Crimes and Punishments," designated as "Section two hundred and eighty-eight A."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That an additional section designated "two hundred and eighty-eight A," be added to article twenty-seven, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Crimes and Punishments," to follow after section two hundred and eighty-eight and to read as follows: To add.

288 A. In any indictment for the unlawful sale or disposition of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer, it shall not be necessary to specify the particular variety, provided the indictment sets forth an unlawful sale or disposition of intoxicating liquor, but the defendant on application to the State's attorney before trial, may obtain a statement of the particular variety of liquor expected to be proved. Not to specify.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

## CHAPTER 430.

AN ACT to give the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to a gift in the will of Robert Johnson to the trustees of the congregation of the disciples of Christ, in the city and precincts of Baltimore.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction and assent of the said General Assembly be and is hereby given and granted to the gift in the will of Robert Johnson, of Baltimore city, to the trustees of the congregation of the disciples of Jesus Christ, in the city and precincts of Baltimore, of one-half of all the rest, residue and remainder of the estate. Assent.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.
