

To pay ized and directed to issue his warrant upon the treasurer to pay George H. Claggett, late collector of State taxes for the third collection district of Charles county, the sum of thirteen dollars and ninety cents (\$13.90,) being the amount over-paid by said George H. Claggett into the treasury as collector of State taxes for the third collection district of Charles county, for the years eighteen hundred and eighty-four and eighteen hundred and eighty-five, as certified by the comptroller and treasurer, the refunding thereof having received the recommendation of said officers.

Effective. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 440.

AN ACT to refund to Edwin H. Ford and John W. Carew a sum of money paid into the treasury.

Preamble. WHEREAS, a fine of two hundred dollars was imposed by M. M. Davis, justice of the peace of the State of Maryland, on the schooner N. B. Anderson and John W. Carew, her master, for alleged violation of the oyster law in November, eighteen hundred and eighty-eight, which proceedings on appeal before the circuit court of Calvert county were quashed and reversed after said fine was paid into the treasury; therefore,

To issue warrant. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the comptroller draw his warrant upon the treasurer in favor of Edwin H. Ford and John W. Carew for the sum of two hundred dollars, being the fine imposed by M. M. Davis, justice of the peace of the State of Maryland in and for Calvert county, in proceedings before him, which proceedings on appeal to the circuit court of Calvert county, were quashed by the court after the fine was paid into the treasury, the same having been approved by the officers of the treasury.

AN ACT giving the leave and sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland, to each of the several leases, deeds and conveyances hereinafter mentioned and specified, of a lot of ground in the city of Baltimore, situate on the northeast corner of Broadway and Monument street, to the several religious corporations
