## CHAPTER 451.

AN ACT to appropriate a certain sum of money for the Ladies' confederate memorial and aid association of Maryland, in Baltimore city.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland. That the sum of one thousand dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated to the Ladies' confederate memorial and aid association of Maryland, in Baltimore city, for each of the years eigh-To approteen hundred and ninety-one and eighteen hundred and ninetytwo: provided, that the trustees of said association shall make written report to this General Assembly at its next session, showing in what manner this appropriation shall have been used, and particularly the number of persons aided by them and for what time, respectively.

## CHAPTER 452.

AN ACT making appropriations for the support of the State government for the fiscal year ending on the thirtieth day of September, eighteen hundred and ninety-two.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That for the expenditures in the support of the State government for the fiscal year beginning with the first day of October, eighteen hundred and ninety-one and ending with the thirtieth day year '91-'92 of September, eighteen hundred and ninety-two, the following sums of money or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated, that is to say:

FOR STATE OFFICERS.

For the salary of the governor, four thousand and five hundred dollars; for the salary of the secretary of State, two thousand dollars; for the salary of the messenger of the governor, one thousand dollars; for the salary of the comptroller of the treasury, two thousand and five hundred dollars; for the salary of the cers' salachief clerk to the comptroller, eighteen hundred dollars; for the salaries of three assistant clerks to the comptroller, twelve hundred dollars each, three thousand six hundred dollars, and for extra clerical services, six hundred dollars; for the salary of the treasurer of the State, two thousand and five hundred dollars; for the salary of the chief clerk to the treasurer, eighteen hun-
