

Misdemeanor. cars or horses, plant of said company, or to any person upon any of said cars, such person or persons shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars, (\$500,) or imprisonment in the county or city jail, or in the house of correction for a period not longer than one year, or by both fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the circuit court for Washington county.

To issue bond. SEC. 10. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be lawful for the said company to issue its bonds in sums of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100) each, bearing interest, payable at such time or times as the president and directors may appoint, and to prescribe for the security and payment of the said bonds by mortgage or otherwise, and to sell and dispose of the said bonds, and apply the proceeds from the sale of same to the payment of the construction and equipment of said railway, or of the liabilities of said company.

Not to authorize. SEC. 11. *And be it enacted*, That nothing in this act contained shall be so construed as to authorize the said company, or its officers or agents, to issue any scrip or bank note, or exercise any banking privileges.

Effective. SEC. 12. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

#### CHAPTER 495.

AN ACT to amend the act incorporating the Baltimore college of dental surgery passed February first, eighteen hundred and forty, so as to increase the amount of property which it may be lawful for said college to acquire.

Empowered. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Baltimore college of dental surgery, incorporated by the act of assembly of Maryland, passed February first, eighteen hundred and forty, be and the same is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire property to the amount of seventy-five thousand dollars in value, in addition to the amount under its charter it is now authorized to acquire.

Effective. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
