other institution, incorporated under the laws of this State, subject to the discipline and regulations of such institution, and to the further order and direction of the court or judge; and any court or judge disposing of the custody of a minor upon habeas corpus may assume and retain jurisdiction over such minor in as ample a manner as a court of chancery, or judge of a court of chancery upon bill or petition, and may pass such other and further orders in relation to his care and custody as may be deemed just and beneficial.

AN ACT to authorize the governor to appoint four additional notaries public for Baltimore city.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Notaries That the governor by and with the advice and consent of the Public. senate, is hereby authorized to appoint four additional notaries public for the city of Baltimore.
