CHAPTER 504.

AN ACT to punish any person who shall falsely represent himself as a member of the police force of Baltimore city, or who shall wear any of the insignia of office worn by the officers of said force.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That it shall be a misdemeanor, punishable by imprisonment in That it shall be a misdemeanor, punishanor of shall be a misdemeanor, punishanor of the misdemeanor.

That it shall be a misdemeanor, punishanor of the misdemeanor. of not less than five dollars, for any person not a member of the police force of Baltimore city, to falsely represent himself as being such member, with fraudulent design upon person or property, or upon any day or at any time to have, use, wear or display, without the authority of the board of police commissioners of Baltimore, any shield, button, wreath, number or any other insignia or emblem of office, such as are worn by the police force of said city.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from Effective. the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 505.

AN ACT to incorporate the Baltimore, South Baltimore and Curtis bay railroad company.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Samuel G. Acton, George N. Potee, John F. Lowekamp, Joseph M. Clark, John F. Williams, William C. Pennington, J. Swan Frick, Hiram Woods and John Gill, of R., be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to take subscription to the capi-Commistal stock of the Baltimore, South Baltimore and Curtis bay railroad company hereby incorporated, and that they, or a majority of them, may cause books to be opened at such times and places and for such period or periods and upon such notice as they may deem expedient, and may re-open the same from time to time for the purpose of receiving subscriptions to said capital stock; and if any of the above named directors shall die, resign or refuse to act, another or others may be appointed in his or their stead by a majority of the remaining commissioners.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the subscribers to said stock and their successors and assigns, shall be and they are hereby To incordeclared to be incorporated into a company by the name of the Baltimore, South Baltimore and Curtis bay railroad company, and by that name shall be capable in law of purchasing, holding, selling and conveying property, real, personal and mixed, as far
