

district shall respectively make separate returns, and separate returns shall in like manner be made by the return judges of the election precincts in said city constituting a part of the fifth congressional district.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

CHAPTER 73.

AN ACT to repeal section two of an act entitled an act supplemental to and to amend an act entitled an act to incorporate the Maryland agricultural and mechanical association, passed March nineteenth, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, approved March twelfth, eighteen hundred and seventy, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section two of an act entitled an act supplemental to and to amend an act entitled an act to incorporate the Maryland agricultural and mechanical association, passed March nineteenth, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, approved March twelfth, eighteen hundred and seventy, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted as follows: Repeal.

SEC. 2. That in case of the dissolution of the Maryland agricultural and mechanical association the trustees named in the act entitled an act to incorporate the Maryland agricultural and mechanical association, chapter one hundred and twenty-eight, passed March nineteenth, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, and their successors shall at once proceed to sell at public auction, after giving the usual notice given by trustees for the sale of property, all the land and improvements thereon, and all other property held by them in trust for the use of said association, for the best price they can obtain for the same, and they may convey title to the same by one of their number, to whom they may delegate authority to convey the same, and who shall give bond to the State of Maryland for the faithful discharge of his trust, in an amount double the value of said property as may be approved by the treasurer of said State; and in case of said sale by the said trustees and their successors, the net proceeds of said sale shall be applied by said trustees and their successors, first, to the payment of all debts due by said association for the land and improvements thereon, and all other debts due by the said association; and after the payment of the said debts in full, the balance of proceeds of said Sell and convey.
