

act; to be applied by said board of visitors and governors to the paying off of said debt and accruing interest; provided that the twenty-six senatorial scholars (one from each senatorial district,) whose board, fuel, lights and washing at said college, as provided for by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter three hundred and fifteen, shall be hereafter received by said college free of tuition, room rent and all other college charges, and before any portion of the amount hereby appropriated is paid over to the order of said board of visitors and governors, said board shall execute and deliver to the comptroller of the State an agreement to that effect.

CHAPTER 555.

AN ACT to repeal sections two hundred and twenty-five, two hundred and twenty-six, two hundred and twenty-seven, two hundred and twenty-eight, two hundred and twenty-nine, two hundred and thirty, two hundred and thirty-one, two hundred and thirty-two, two hundred and thirty-three and two hundred thirty-four, of article twenty-four, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, entitled "Worcester county," sub-title "Roads."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That sections two hundred and twenty-five, two hundred and twenty-six, two hundred and twenty-seven, two hundred and twenty-eight, two hundred and twenty-nine, two hundred and thirty, two hundred and thirty-one, two hundred and thirty-two, two hundred and thirty-three and two hundred and thirty-four, of article twenty-four, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, entitled "Worcester county," sub-title "Roads," be and the same are hereby repealed. **Repealed.**

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. **Effective.**
