CHAPTER 568.

AN ACT to repeal sections fifty-five to eighty-nine, both inclusive of article fifty-six, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Licenses to sell spirituous or fermented liquors by retailers," so far as the same apply to the city of Annapolis, and to repeal section fifty-five, of article two, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel county," sub-title "Liquors and intoxicating drinks," regulating the sale of intoxicating liquors in the city of Annapolis, and to add new sections to said article two, of the Code of Public Local Laws, to follow section one hundred and eighty-four, to be designated as "Sections one hundred and eighty-four A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K, L, M, N, O, P, Q, R, and S.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That sections fifty-five to eighty-nine, both inclusive, of article fifty-six, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Licenses to sell spirituous or fermented liquors by retailers," so far as they apply to the city of Annapolis, be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That section fifty-five, of article two, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel county," sub-title "Liquor and intoxicating drinks," be and the same is Newsechereby repealed, and that new sections to come in after section one tions to be added hundred and eighty-four, of said article two be added thereto, to be known alphabetically as "Numbers one hundred and eightyfour A, to one hundred and eighty-four S," inclusive.
