registries pertaining to the election precinct or election district over which said judges are to preside.

30. The respective judges of election shall receive from the respective sheriffs of their respective counties or from the said board of supervisors of elections in the city of Baltimore, the board of supervisors of elections in the casy of control of their registries of qualified and registered voters pertaining to their respective election precincts or election districts and preserve the to be decided to be decided as a defendment while in their livered same without alteration, mutilation or defacement while in their possession, and shall within two days after the close of their respective polls in their respective election districts or election precincts return to said respective sheriffs or to the said board of supervisors of elections in the city of Baltimore the said registries of qualified and registered voters from them respectively received; and the said respective sheriffs and the said board of supervisors of elections in the city of Baltimore shall upon so receiving the same forthwith deliver the same to the clerks of the respective courts from which the same were respectively received; the said respective judges of shall not at any election receive or deposit in the ballot-box the ballot of any person offering to vote until they have found his name in the registry for their respective election precincts or election districts, delivered to them for the purposes precincts or election districts, delivered to them for the purposes of said election and shall be satisfied that the person so offering Names to be found to vote is the person named in said list, and have checked it thereon in the column ruled thereon for the purpose; and they shall receive and deposit in the ballot-box the ballot of every person offering to vote whose name appears in said respective registries.

31. Each of said officers of registration in Baltimore city shall be entitled to receive thirty dollars per annum for the discharge of his official duties exclusive of office rent and the cost of stationery; and each of said registration officers in the county shall receive seventy-five dollars and no more per annum for the dis-salaries charge of his official duties exclusive of office rent and the cost of stationery; the said respective officers of registration shall be paid the said compensation if appointed to act in the city of Baltimore by the mayor and city council of Baltimore, and if appointed to act in any county of this State by the county commissioners of said county; the clerk of the superior court of Baltimore city shall receive one cent for every ten words or figures of any copy of any registry of voters or part of any registry of voters of any election precinct in said city, and such copy shall be furnished by the said clerk within five days after the demand therefor; the respective clerks of the respective circuit courts for the respective counties shall receive the same compensation for the same services; but the officers of registration shall not be entitled to charge or receive any fees for copies furnished by them of the entries relating to the name of any person on their books
