

six to exhibit his license, and any such officer may enter the premises where apple cider is sold, and upon paying therefor at the regular prices, demand and receive from one pint to one quart if any cider or other liquor or drink sold on said premises, and such officers shall be entitled to demand and receive such quantity from every cask or other vessel on said premises.

SUB-SEC. 8. If any person or firm, or the member of any firm on the premises thereof shall commit any of the offenses mentioned in this sub-section, he or it shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof in the circuit court or before any justice of the peace of Dorchester county, said person or the members of said firm, shall be punished as hereinafter provided; if any person or firm, or the member of any firm on its premises, (other than the maker or producer of the cider or apples,) in any of the election districts of said county where the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors is unlawful, shall sell any apple cider without first having obtained a license therefor to sell the same, or if any person or firm, or the member of any firm on its premises, shall sell or have for sale in any of said districts any apple cider not made in said county from apples produced therein, such person or firm shall be fined not less than fifty nor more than one hundred dollars, and shall stand committed till fine and costs are paid, or in default of payment for one month, and if any dealer in cider shall have on the premises where the business is carried on, or in close vicinity thereto, any cider more than three gallons of apple cider not made in said county from fruit produced therein, such fact shall be *prima facie* evidence that said dealer has the same on hand for sale; if any person or firm, or the member of any firm on its premises, shall in any of said election districts sell or have on hand for sale any cider, except apple cider; if any person or firm, or member of any firm on its premises, in any of said districts, shall sell or have on hand for sale any apple cider adulterated by being mixed with alcohol or any intoxicating liquor, or by being affected with any drug whatever, and if the maker of any apple cider or the grower of the fruit in said county, shall adulterate said cider by mixing it with alcohol or any alcoholic or other intoxicating liquor, or by affecting it with any drug whatever, whether such adulteration takes place before or after the sale thereof, the said person or firm shall be confined in the house of correction not less than two nor more than four months; provided, that if the person or persons so convicted shall before sentence tender the payment, and pay such fine as the court or justice may direct, not less than one hundred nor more than two hundred dollars, the court or justice may sentence such person or persons to be imprisoned in the county jail of said county instead of the house of correction, for not less than two nor more than four months; and, provided, further, that if any
