Giddings; thence running with said Weems' creek to its mouth at a point where it empties into the Severn river; thence with said river to the point where the lands of the United States government join to the lands of said heirs of Luther Giddings; thence limits with the division line between said last named lands to a point where said lands of the heirs of Luther Giddings join the lands of Daniel R. Magruder; thence with the division line between said last named lands and also the lands of said William Feldmeyer to the place of beginning.

Election

SEC. 3. Be it enacted, That the citizens of West Annapolis, of the age of twenty-one years and upwards, who have resided in said town for six months next preceding the election shall, on the first of commis-sioners. day of May, eighteen hundred and ninety-one, and on the first day of May in each year thereafter, elect three real estate owners who have resided in said town for six months next preceding said election as commissioners of West Annapolis to serve for one year of until their successors shall be elected and qualified they shall receive no pay for their services.

Election

SEC. 4. Be it enacted, That the commissioners of West Annapolis shall, at their first meeting after an election elect one of dent, etc. their number to be president of the board, and all vacancies in the board of commissioners of West Annapolis shall be filled by an election held after ten days previous notice given by the remaining members of said board.

Meetings

SEC. 5. Be it enacted, That the commissioners of West Annapolis shall meet in said town on or before the first Monday in June after their election and as often thereafter as they may deem necessary.

Sec. 6. Be it enacted, That the commissioners of West An-Appoint a napolis shall annually appoint a clerk, who shall keep the minutes of the proceedings in a well bound book which shall be open to inspection of all persons therein, and shall perform such other duties as the commissioners of West Annapolis may assign him.

SEC. 7. Be it enacted, That the commissioners of West Annapolis shall annually, on or before the first Monday in April, appoint Marper of three judges of election, who shall conduct the election accord-elections ing to the election laws of Maryland, except that the polls shall be opened at four o'clock, p. m., and close at six o'clock, p. m.; the first election to be held under the provisions of this act, shall be held on the first day of May, eighteen hundred and ninety-one, and William S. Ridgely, J. West Aldridge and George T. Melvin, are hereby appointed commissioners of West Annapolis until said first day of May, eighteen hundred and ninety-one, and until their successors shall have been elected and qualified under the provisions of this act.
