of which, exclusive of libraries, and philosophical and chemical, and other apparatus intended for and in the use of the college, shall not have an actual annual value of more than ten thousand dollars, and the same or any part thereof, to dispose of at their pleasure, and to execute such deed or deeds as may be necessary therefor, to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, but nothing herein contained shall be so construed as to confer any banking privilege upon the said corporation, or any authority to issue any note, certificate, device or token to be used as currency; provided that a majority of said corporators or their successors shall, at all times, be citizens of the United States.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That James Gibbons, archbishop of Baltimore, and his successors in the see of Baltimore, in the perpetuity, be and he and they are constituted in the order in which Honorary. they may hold and enjoy said see, incumbents of the office of honorary president of said collegiate institute for young ladies and preparatory school for little girls.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That the General Assembly of Maryland hereby expressly reserves the power at all times to repeal, Reservaalter or amend this charter; provided, however, that when the said charter shall be repealed, all the property, real, personal and mixed, then belonging to the said association, or their successors, in possession or action shall remain with and belong to the proper owners thereof, their assignees or legal representatives.
