of said committee had been duly elected and qualified, and were members of said church, as required by the act of incorporation of said committee.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted. That the regular time or times for the election of the said committee, shall hereafter be as appointed by the said act of incorporation, and that at any future election of the members of said committee, any male members of the congregation of said church being twenty-one years of age or over, and who shall be entitled to vote for a pastor of said church, shall be eligible as a member of said committee, and any member of the Entitled congregation who may be entitled to vote for a pastor of said church, shall be entitled to vote for members of said committee; provided, that if new members of said committee shall not be elected at the time or times appointed by said act of incorporation, a new election may be held at any subsequent time, on the same notice as now required by law; and provided, that the election and qualification of the members of the existing committee of said church shall be, and the same are hereby declared to be valid and legal, and said committee and all committees hereafter elected shall hold over until their successor shall be elected and shall qualify.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the said corporation shall be May purchase. capable of purchasing real and personal property, not exceeding in value the sum of twenty thousand dollars.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from Biffective. the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 633.

AN ACT to regulate the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer, and the issuing of licenses therefor in the town of New Windsor and in New Windsor district, and also in the town of Uniontown and Uniontown district, Carroll county, Maryland.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That any person or persons, or body corporate in the towns of Uniontown or New Windsor, Carroll county, who may desire to procure a license to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or lager Applicabeer within the corporate limits of the said town, shall, on or before the first day of May, in each and every year, beginning with the year eighteen hundred and ninety, file with the clerk of the
