

**File claim.** court for the county or the superior court of Baltimore city as the case may be; and which shall be re-delivered by such clerk to the party filing the same after it has been recorded as provided in section eighteen.

**Effective** SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

#### CHAPTER 108.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claim of A. Lingen Jarrett, clerk of the circuit court for Harford county, for money erroneously paid into the State treasury.

**To draw.** SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the comptroller of the State be and he is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant upon the treasurer of the State in favor of A. Lingen Jarrett, clerk of the circuit court for Harford county, for the sum of forty-seven dollars and fifty cents, (\$47.50) being the amount erroneously paid into the State treasury for real estate license; the passage of this bill having been recommended by the officers of the treasury department of this State.

**Effective** SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

#### CHAPTER 109.

AN ACT to amend the charter of Loudon Park cemetery company.

**Add to or sell.** SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Loudon Park cemetery company, a body corporate of the State of Maryland, be and it is hereby authorized and empowered to increase the size of its cemetery by purchasing and holding not more than one hundred additional acres of land adjacent to its present cemetery for purposes of sepulture, and to sell, at any time, any portion of its land it may not deem expedient to use for cemetery purposes.

**To hold.** SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the said corporation may purchase and hold such real and leasehold property in Baltimore city for office purposes as it may deem suitable for conducting its business and to sell the same at pleasure.
