

four dollars and sixteen and two-third cents per month, from May first, eighteen hundred and eighty-eight to December seven-teenth, eighteen hundred and eighty-eight.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the treasurer of the State of Maryland be and he is hereby required upon the warrant of the comptroller of the State, to pay to Zachariah W. Taylor the sum of seven dollars and ninety cents; **To repay.** to Wesley Clarkson, the sum of seven dollars and ninety cents; to Nathaniel Baker, the sum of seven dollars and ninety cents; to L. Samuel Perdue, the sum of twenty-three dollars and seventy cents; to Matthias Taylor and William J. Bennett, partners, trading as Taylor and Bennett, the sum of twenty-three dollars and seventy cents, and to Thomas H. C. Morgan the sum of twenty-seven dollars and sixty-five cents for double license paid into the treasury of Maryland.

Effective. **SEC. 2.** *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
