An act to appropriate to the payment of the outstanding overdue debt of the State, issued under chapter forty-one of the acts of eighteen hundred and forty-seven so much of the money received of the United States in settlement of the claim of the State for direct war taxes, as may be necessary therefor, and to forbid the further issue of the exchange loan of eighteen hundred and ninety-one authorized therefor to the extent of the debt so paid and to appropriate the balance of said direct taxes to the general sinking fund. . . . 143
- No. 98. An act to repeal chapter four hundred and eighty-five of the act passed at January session eighteen hundred and ninety of the General Assembly of Maryland, entitled an act to repeal and re-enact chapter one hundred and fifty-two of the acts passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled an act to repeal chapter four hundred and twenty-nine of the acts passed at the January session eighteen hundred and seventy-four, entitled an act to incorporate a company to construct a turnpike road from Hagerstown, in Washington County, to the town of Sharpsburg, passed at January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-three, chapter one hundred and twenty-nine, and re-enact said sections with amendments. . . . . 144
- No. 99. An act to repeal section fifty-one of article twenty-seven of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Destroying Property Maliciously," and to re-enact the same with amendments. . . . . 145

An act to repeal and re-enact with an amendment section one hundred and seventy-one of article ninety-three of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Testamentary Law," sub-title "Guardian and Ward," as repealed and re-enacted by the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, January session of eighteen hundred and ninety, chapter two hundred and eleven. . . . . 146
- No. 101. An act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section one of chapter 589 of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session 1890, entitled an act to protect birds and game, and prevent trespassing with dog or gun on private property in Somerset County. . . 147
