No. 216. An act to authorize the County Commissioners of Washington County to issue "Bonds" for building a school house in Hagerstown, in election district No. 21, in said county, and to levy a tax for the payment of the same. 295

No. 217. An act to carry into effect section one of article seven of the constitution of this State, so far as the same relates to Baltimore County, and to repeal section thirty-one of article three of the Public Local Laws, title "Baltimore County," sub-title "County Commissioners," and to re-enact the same with amendments. 296

No. 218. An act to repeal and re-enact with amendments new section one hundred and forty-five of article thirty-three of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Elections," as enacted by the act of eighteen hundred and ninety, chapter five hundred and thirty-eight. 297

No. 219. An act to repeal section 810 of article 4 of the Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Streets, Bridges and Highways," and to re-enact the same with amendments. 298

No. 220. An act authorizing and directing H. Fillmore Lankford, clerk of the Circuit Court for Somerset County, to refund to George M. France the sum of forty-eight dollars for illegal fines paid by him, for alleged violations of the Local Oyster Law of Somerset County in the State of Maryland. 299

No. 221. An act to enable the qualified voters of election district number thirteen in Frederick County to determine by ballot whether spirituous or fermented liquors shall be sold in said district. 300

No. 222. An act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section twelve of article thirty-six of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Fees of Officers," sub-title "Clerks of Courts." 302

No. 223. An act to repeal section six hundred and seven of article four, of the Code of Public Local Laws, of Maryland,
