No. 445. An act to prohibit the payment of employees of certain corporations, operating in Garrett County otherwise than in legal tender money of the United States. . . . . 640

No. 446. An act to authorize the council of Brunswick of Frederick County, to issue improvement bonds to an amount not exceeding the sum of twenty thousand dollars. . . . . 641

No. 447. An act to add additional sections to article fifty-six of the Code of Public General Laws, title "License," sub-title "Penalties," to be designated as section eighty-nine B, and eighty-nine C, relating to obtaining liquors by minors and giving liquors to minors. . . . . 642

No. 448. An act to add a new article to the Code of Public General Laws to be known as "Stationary Engineers," and to be numbered article 101. . . . . 643

No. 449. An act to empower the County Commissioners of Charles County, in their discretion, to levy a sum of money for the building of a school house for white children in Harris' Lot section, fifth election district of Charles County. . . . . 647

No. 451. An act to incorporate the Elkton Electric Light and Power Company . . . . . 648

No. 452. An act to carry into effect section one of article seven of the Constitution of this State, so far as the same relates to Howard County, and to repeal section thirty-nine of article fourteen of the Public Local Laws, title "Howard County," sub-title "County Commissioners and County Collectors" and to re-enact the same with amendments. . . . . 651

No. 455. An act to authorize the County Commissioners of Montgomery County to subscribe to the capital stock of turnpike companies in said county. . . . . 652

No. 457. An act to regulate the deposit of money in the hands of public officers of Kent County, in the national banks at Chestertown. . . . . 653

An act to prohibit the issuing of any license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer at or within one-half mile of "Narrows Park" as now enclosed, the terminus of the Cumberland Electric Railway Company, located on the line of the National Turnpike road, about two miles west of the city of Cumberland, in Allegany County; and to prevent the sale of all kinds of intoxicating drinks in the above described limits. . . . . 653
