No. 478. An act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, section two hundred and thirty-six, of article twenty-two, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Hancock." 673

No. 479. An act to authorize the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel County to borrow money on the credit of the County for the purpose of repairing, enlarging and remodeling the court house of said county to issue bonds for the payment of the same and to levy taxes on the assessable property of said county to redeem said bonds and to pay the interest thereon, and to provide for the repairing, enlarging and remodeling and furnishing of said court house. 674

No. 480. An act to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County to appoint one additional constable for the third and sixth election districts of said county jointly. 678

No. 481. An act to authorize the County Commissioners of Charles County, in their discretion, to pay Joseph M. Hayden a certain sum of money on account of taxes paid in error. 678

No. 482. An act to authorize the Cumberland Valley Railroad Company to connect with the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal at or near Powell's Bend where its railroad bridge crosses said canal, and the Potomac River. 679

No. 483. An act to prevent the sale of fermented, or spirituous liquors or lager beer within a radius of one mile and a half from the point of crossing of the Baltimore and Yorktown Turnpike and the Northern Central Railway at Parkton, in Baltimore County. 679

No. 484. An act to repeal section 361 of article 4 of the Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Harbor, Docks and Wharves," and to re-enact the same with amendments. 680
