

CHAPTER 80.

AN ACT to repeal section one hundred and eighty-five of article ten of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester County," sub-title "Fish," as the same was repealed and re-enacted by the act of eighteen hundred and ninety, chapter five hundred and sixteen, and to re-enact the same with amendments and to add an additional section thereto, to be designated section one hundred and eighty-five B.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section one hundred and eighty-five of article ten of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester County," sub-title "Fish," as the same was repealed and re-enacted by the act of eighteen hundred and ninety, chapter five hundred and sixteen be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows :

Repealed.

SEC. 185. It shall be unlawful for any person to use patent twine weirs or other twine weirs, pound nets, fykes or hauling seines of greater length than three hundred and fifty feet, for taking or catching fish, terapins or crabs in the following waters of Dorchester County: All that part of Fishing Bay north of a line from roasting ear point, to the upper side of Duck Island Cove, or any of the tributaries of Honga River, Little Choptank and its tributaries, provided that the provisions of the sub-title of this article shall not apply to that portion of the Little Choptank River, and the tributaries thereof lying south of a line drawn from James' Point to the north end or limit of the point of land on the Susquehanna shore on the west side of the mouth of Woolford's Creek.

Unlawful to use weirs, pound nets, &c. in Dorchester County.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the following new section to be designated one hundred and eighty-five B, be and the same is hereby added to said article ten, to-wit :

New Section,

SEC. 185 B. It shall be unlawful for any person, except a bona-fide resident of Bucktown and Drawbridge districts in Dorchester County, to use any patent twine weir or other twine weir, pound net, fyke, stick weir or hauling seine for the purpose of taking or catching fish in Trausquakin River or its tributaries, except in that part of said Trausquakin River and its tributaries which runs and flows beyond and outside of the said Bucktown and Drawbridge districts. It shall also be unlawful for the bona-fide residents of Bucktown and Drawbridge districts to obstruct and occupy with their patent twine weirs or otheir twine weirs, pound nets,
