

Borrow money and issue bonds bridge in such manner as said commissioners may deem proper; and for the purpose of paying for the said repairs and improvements to said bridge, the said County Commissioners are hereby authorized to borrow on the credit of said county such sum or sums of money as may be necessary, not exceeding in all the sum of five thousand dollars, and to give their bonds, notes or bills obligatory therefor in sums of not more than one thousand dollars each, to be signed by the president of the board of said commissioners, and to be countersigned by the county treasurer of said county, and have the corporate seal of said commissioners affixed thereto, bearing interest not exceeding six per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually on the first day of January and of July in each and every year from the date thereof until the same are paid.

Bonds—when payable. SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That said bonds, notes or bills obligatory shall be redeemable at the pleasure of the said County Commissioners at or before the maturity thereof, and shall be made payable at such times that not more than one thousand dollars thereof shall mature in any one year.

Levy tax SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted,* That the County Commissioners are hereby authorized and empowered to levy annually upon the assessable property of Dorchester County a tax sufficient to pay the semi-annual interest on said bonds, notes or bills obligatory by them issued in pursuance of this act, and they shall also levy when necessary such additional sum or sums as may be requisite to pay the principal of said bonds, notes or bills obligatory as the same may accrue when due.

Effective. SEC. 4. *And be it further enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 83.

AN ACT to repeal section 37 of article 19 of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Comptroller," and to re-enact with an amendment.

Repealed and re-enacted. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section 37 of article 19 of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Comptroller," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows :

SEC. 37. The Comptroller is authorized and empowered to adjust and settle the claims of the State against all col-
