CHAPTER 101.

AN ACT to reapeal and re-enact with amendments section one of chapter 589 of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session 1890, entitled an act to protect birds and game, and prevent trespassing with dog or gun on private property in Somerset County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section one of chapter 589 of the acts of the Repeal and General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session reenact ment. 1890, entitled an act to protect birds and game, and prevent trespassing with dog or gun on private property in Somerset County, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

SEC. 1. That it shall not be lawful for any person or persons in Somerset County to shoot, kill, catch, or entrap in any manner whatever, any partridges or quail in said county between the fifteenth day of February and the first day of November in each and every year; nor any wild duck between partridges, the first day of April and the first day of October in each woodcook, and every year; nor any hare or rabbit between the fifteenth be himted day of January and the first day of November in each and Somerset every year; nor any woodcock between the first day of Jan-County. uary and the tenth day of June in each and every year; nor any muskrat between the twentieth day of March and the first day of December in each and every year; nor any wild goose between the first day of April and the first day of November in each and every year.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect reflective. from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 102.

AN ACT to pay Charles F. Rowe, late collector of State taxes for Frederick County for years 1888 and 1889 a sum of money for State taxes paid by him into the treasury erroneously.
