CHAPTER 118.

AN ACT to sanction the devise by Sarah Ann Taylor, late of Charles County, of certain real estate to the vestry of Durham Parish of the Protestant Episcopal Church of said county.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sanction and consent of said General Assembly be and the same is hereby given to the gift and devise by Sarah Ann Taylor, late of Charles County, deceased, contained in her last will and testament, duly admitted to probate and of record in the office of the Register of Wills of said county to the vestry of Durham Parish of the Protestant Episcopal Church of said county of an interest in certain real estate in said will described.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this act shall Effective. take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 119.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Caroline County to appoint an additional constable for the first election district of Caroline County.
