SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect Effective from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 121.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the Governor to appoint an additional justice of the peace for each of election districts No. one, four and seven in Charles County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Governor be, and he is hereby authorized Additional and empowered to appoint an additional justice of the peace the peace for each of election districts No. one, four and seventh of County. Charles County, Maryland.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this act shall Effective take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 122.

AN ACT to repeal sections 230 and 231 of article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Courts," relating to court stenographers, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland. That section two hundred and thirty and two Repealed hundred and thirty-one of article 4 of the Code of Public and re-enacted. Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Courts," be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted, so as to read as follows:

SEC. 230. The Judges of the Supreme Bench of Baltimore City are authorized and directed to appoint from time to time as many court stenographers, not exceeding in number altogether the number of said judges, as shall in their disphere altogether the number of sura jacage, the several courts of Battanore cretion be required for the services of the several courts of Baltimore City, who shall be sworn officers of the court, and shall each be paid a salary of fifteen hundred dollars per annum, when such stenographers shall be required to attend
