apply in this State, be and is hereby authorized and directed to make suitable provisions for complying with all the requirements of the said act.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted. That this act shall take effect Effective from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 126.

AN ACT to repeal section one hundred and ninety-two of article twenty-two of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Hagerstown," and to re-enact the same with amendments, and add new sections to said article twenty-two of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," "Hagerstown," to follow section one hundred and seventy one of said article and to be known as section one hundred and seventy-one B, one hundred and seventy-one C, one hundred and seventy-one D, of said article twentytwo of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Hagerstown."

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Maryland, That section one hundred and ninetytwo of article twenty-two of the Code of Public Local Laws, re-enacted. title "Washington County," sub-title "Hagerstown," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

SEC. 192. They shall appoint a number of regular policemen not exceeding five, to serve under such regulations and for such compensation as they may direct; such compensa-Policemen, tion, however, not to exceed forty dollars per month, and tion, &c subject to removal for cause; they shall have power to appoint special policemen, if in their judgment the exigencies of the town so require; provided, however, that the term of appointment of such special policemen shall not extend beyond a period of forty-eight hours.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the following new sections, to be known and designated as sections number one hundred and seventy-one B, section one hundred and seventy-one C, and added. one hundred and seventy-one D, to follow section one hundred and seventy-one A, of article twenty-two of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title
