Susanna Warfield, late of Carrol County, deceased. and which will bears date the thirtieth day of May in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-two, that is to say; first the devise of land and the bequeaths of personalty to the convention of the Protestant Episcopal Church of the diocese of Maryland contained in said will and codicils; second, the bequest of six thousand dollars made by said will to the vestry of the parish of the Holy Trinity in Carroll County.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this act shall Effective take effect from its passage.

CHAPTER 128.

AN ACT to authorize the burgess and commissioners of Middletown, Frederick County, Maryland, to issue bonds for the purpose of constructing, operating and keeping in repair, water works for said town.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the burgess and commissioners of Middletown, Frederick County, Maryland be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to issue bonds in the name of the said municipal corporation, to an amount not exceeding the sum of eleven thousand dollars (\$11,000) the bonds to be issued under the provisions of this act, shall be issued in sums of not less than fifty dollars nor more than five hundred dollars each, and the said bonds shall be sealed with the corporate seal, signed by the burgess and countersigned by the clerk of the Board of Commissioners of said town, each of the said bonds shall be payable, thirty years Payable. after date, to bearer; redeemable, however, at the pleasure of the said burgess and commissioners at any time after the expiration of ten years, from their respective dates, bearing interest not exceeding five per cent per annum, payable annually, by the burgess of the said municipal corporation on presentation of interest coupons, to be issued with the bonds.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the proceeds of the sale Proceeds of the bonds, hereby authorized to be issued, shall be of bonds. applied to the construction and maintenance of a reservoir and all the mains leading thereto, from the source of supply on North Mountain, also mains and fire plugs along said line in and through the streets and alleys of Middletown, as a protection against fire, for the use of the citizens and any manufactures that may be established in said town.
