Shall not than nine, and if, at any time, the number shall be reduced be less than seven by death, resignation, or otherwise, the remaining trustees shall fill the vacancy within thirty days, or on failure to do so, the vacancy shall be filled by the mayor of Baltimore City.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the said corporation and capable its successors, by the name and title as aforesaid shall be hereafter capable in law, to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, answer and be answered, unto, defend and be defended in all courts of justice, and before all and any judge, officer, or person whatsover, in all and singular actions, matters or demands whatsoever.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That it shall and may be lawa common seal for its use, and the same, at its will and pleasure to change, after and make anew from time to time, as it may think best; and it shall have and exercise all such rights and priviliges, as by law, are incident or necessary to corporations.

May may at any time, when it may deem the same necessary, alter or repeal this act.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect Effective from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 132.

AN ACT to repeal chapter six hundred and eighteen of the acts of eighteen hundred and ninety, title "Justice of the Peace," sub-title "Criminal Jurisdiction," so far as it applies to Talbot County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That chapter six hundred and eighteen of the acts of eighteen hundred and ninety, be and the same is hereby repealed so far as it applies to Talbot County.

Effective. SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
