by the election of a suitable and qualified man by a majority vote of the remaining trustees duly called together for that Such Board of Trustees shall duly hold and manage all the real and leasehold property and permanent investments of said association, and suffer and permit the same and the income therefrom to be used, occupied and applied by the said association for its own use and the use of its branches, under the direction of the Board of Directors, so long as the same be used and the income applied and expended for the legitimate objects of said association or its branches, and all such property, so managed by the said Board of nine Trustees in conformity with the provisions of this section shall not be sold, encumbered or otherwise disposed of without the concurrent consent of both the Board of Directors and the Board of Trustees.

Intoxicants or

SEC. 7. And be it enacted, That no intoxicating drinks nor games of lager beer, shall be sold or used, or games of chance allowed upon any part of the real estate owned by this corporation.

Branch tions

SEC. 8. And be it enacted, That the Board of Directors of said association shall have power to establish and maintain either in whole or in part, such branch associations as are now existing or may hereafter be established in the City of Associa- Baltimore and vicinity, as they may deem advisable, and the same to discontinue at the discretion of the said Board of Directors; also to appoint a committee of management for each branch of three or more suitable members of such branch who may be connected with different religious denominations, and also to designate the chairman of such committee of management. Said chairman, so designated, shall by virtue of his office, as chairman of such branch, be and become a member of the Board of Directors and entitled to represent such branch and have all the rights and privileges of membership in said board so long as he continues in said office as chairman of such branch.

Privileges and Rights.

SEC. 9. And be it enacted, That the members of said corporation and its officers heretofore elected, shall be entitled to the same grade of membership, privileges and rights subject to the same obligations in the corporation as hereby amended and perpetuated by this act, and upon filing with the clerk of the Superior Court of Baltimore City, to be recorded among the Charter Records thereof, a certificate under the hand of the president and secretary, and the seal of said association, of the acceptance by said association of the provisions of this act by the concurrent vote of the present Board of Directors and also of the members of said association entitled to vote under their present constitution and
