Property.

SEC. 10. *And be enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

CHAPTER 24.

AN ACT to declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland, to a devise contained in the last will and testament of Harriet A. Hayden, deceased.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sanction of the said General Assembly, be and the same is hereby given to the devise of a ground rent on a lot of ground on the west side of North Eutaw Street, in the City of Baltimore, to the vestry of St. Luke's Church, in said city, contained in the last will and testament of Harriet A. Hayden, late of Baltimore City, deceased, dated the fifteenth day of August, eighteen hundred and seventy-six, and recorded in the office of the Register of Wills of said city, in wills, Liber R. L. B., No. 64, folio 516, &c. Devise.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

CHAPTER 25.

AN ACT to add an additional section to article twenty-seven of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Crimes and Punishment," sub-title "Embezzlement of Property and Writings," to provide for the punishment of embezzlement.
