

SEC. 237. There shall be appointed during the month of April, annually, one person as supervisor, possessing the same qualifications as the mayor, whose duty it shall be to ^{Supervisor.} superintend the improvements of the town, and who shall perform such other duties as the mayor and city council may prescribe, and he shall be allowed such compensation as shall be fixed by them, and in case of a vacancy in the said office a new appointment shall be made for the residue by the mayor and city council.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That the following additional sections be and the same are hereby added to said article seventeen. ^{To be Added.}

SEC. 246 B. The mayor and city council of Laurel may by ordinance require each and every land owner to keep the side walks and pavements in front of their respective premises in repair and require it to be done upon such notice as the mayor and city council may prescribe, and in case of failure of the land owner to do so within such time as may be prescribed, the mayor and city council shall have power to do the same, charge the same to said land owner or owners and the expenses incurred shall be a lien on the land of said owner or owners and be collected as other taxes. ^{To keep sidewalks in repair.}

SEC. 246 C. The mayor and city council of Laurel shall have the power in order to enable them to contract for water in said town with any company, corporation or individual to levy an additional tax of not more than ten cents on each one hundred dollars worth of assessable property in said town, to be levied and collected as other town taxes are now collected, which said sum when collected, less cost of collection, shall be applied to this purpose and none other. ^{Power to contract for water.}

Provided, that in making the contracts for water they shall bind the company, corporation, or individual to keep the water works in complete repair and working order and continue their working at such periods and intervals as will furnish and fully supply water, sufficient at least to protect the whole town from fire, and furnish, maintain and supply pipes, mains and plugs sufficient for said purpose, the performance of said agreements to be a condition precedent to the payment of the rent for said water. No contract to be made for more than two years at a time. ^{Proviso}

SEC. 246 D. In order to enable the mayor and city council of Laurel to contract for lighting said town, they shall have power to levy a sum not exceeding ten cents on each one hundred dollars worth of assessable property in ^{Power to contract for lighting.}
