

and in compliance with section three hundred and fifty-five of the revised statutes of the United States, consent to purchase is hereby given, and exclusive jurisdiction ceded to the United States, over and with respect to all the lands at or near the battlefield of Antietam in this State, which are now or may at any time hereafter, be acquired by the United States, for the purpose, as specified in the act of Congress, approved August 30th, 1890, of locating, marking and preserving the lines and positions of the armies on said battlefields, and erecting, marking tablets or monuments, and also of laying out roads and approaches, planting trees or shrubbery, fencing and otherwise occupying and embellishing the said battlefield and its vicinity; said jurisdiction to continue so long as the said lands are held and occupied by the United States for public purposes, reserving, however, to this State, a concurrent jurisdiction for the execution upon said lands or in the buildings erected thereon, of all process, civil or criminal, lawfully issued by the courts of the State and not incompatible with this cession; provided that an accurate map or plan of said lands, when laid out, shall be filed in the proper office of record of the county in which said lands are situated.

## CHAPTER 175.

AN ACT to regulate the county printing and publishing in Baltimore County, and to provide for having the same done by contract.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Baltimore County may before making their annual levy in each and every year, contract for the printing and publishing for Baltimore County, of the annual statement, notices of Registration and elections and annual tax levy and tax sales, in so many newspapers respectively as the same are now required by law to be published and for such other printing as is or may be required to be done for said county for the period of one year from the date of making such contract; and such contract shall be at the lowest prices obtainable for the work to be done.
