Publishing publishing the Public Local Laws, passed at each session public local of the General Assembly so long as the same are required by law to be published in said county.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 176.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 123 of article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Election Districts."

Repeal and re-enact-ment SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section 123 of article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Election Districts," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:

Proviso.

123. The county commissioners shall have the power and authority to create new election districts, in addition to those already established, whenever in their judgment the convenience of the voters of the county, or any part thereof, will thereby be promoted: and shall also have power to abridge or enlarge any district heretofore etablished by the Legislature or which may hereafter be established by said commissioners; and shall have the further power to designate the places of holding the election polls in all election districts; provided, however, that the voting or polling place in Ringold district (known as the fourteenth district) shall be held only at Ringold in every year in which a general or special election shall be held.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Approved March 22nd, 1892.
