SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That the said County Commissioners are hereby authorized and empowered to levy a tax annually upon the assessable property of said county sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds, so issued, and the principal of such bonds as they mature in each and every year.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That the bonds hereby authorized to be issued, shall be exempt from all taxation, except taxation for State purposes, and the coupons for interest due on said bonds shall be received by the collector of taxes for said county in payment of county taxes.

Approved February 25th, 1892.

CHAPTER 28.

AN ACT to pay John Waters for work done under contract with the Board of Public Works on tobacco warehouses, numbers one, two, three and four.

SECTION 1, Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer to pay John Waters the sum of eight thousand, one hundred and eighteen dollars and twenty cents (\$8,118.20) for work done on tobacco ware houses, numbers one, two, three and four, by order of the Board of Public Works.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect Effective. from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 29.

AN ACT to repeal article eighty-nine of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Statistics and Information as to Branches of Industry," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That article eighty-nine of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title, "Statistics and Informa-tion as to Branches of Industry," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:
