

## CHAPTER 192.

AN ACT to refund to William A. Lyon, collector of taxes in the seventh election district of St. Mary's County, a sum of money erroneously paid by him into the treasury of the State.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the comptroller of the State be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant upon the treasurer in favor of William A. Lyon, for the sum of sixty-one dollars and seventy-three cents, the same being the amount overpaid into the treasury of the State by the said William A. Lyon, as collector of State taxes in said election district of said county, for the years eighteen hundred and eighty-eight, eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, and eighteen hundred and ninety, the same being recommended by the officers of the treasury department.

Effective. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 193.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments section two hundred and fourteen of article twelve of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Garrett County," sub-title "Sheep."

Repealed. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section two hundred and fourteen of article twelve of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Garrett County," sub-title "Sheep," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows :

SEC. 214. It shall be lawful to kill any dog seen running sheep in Garrett County, and owners of dogs shall be liable for all sheep killed or injured by them, and any person seeing such dogs running at large may lawfully kill the same.

Effective. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
