CHAPTER 197.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money for the support of the Co-operative Workers of Baltimore City.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sum of one thousand dollars a year for Appropria-each of the years eighteen hundred and ninety-two, and Co-opera-eighteen hundred and ninety-three, be and the same is hereby tive Work-ers of appropriated to the Co-operative Workers of Baltimore Baltimore City, for the support of their building known as Vacation Lodge, at Blue Ridge Summit, Maryland, and that the Treasurer of this State be and he is hereby directed on the warrant of the Comptroller to pay to the treasurer of the said Co-operative Workers of Baltimore City, the sum of one thousand dollars for each of the years aforesaid.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this act shall Effective. take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 198.

AN ACT to enable the mayor and city council of Baltimore to appropriate money for the relief of the Baltimore Manual Labor School for Indigent Boys.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the mayor and city council of Baltimore be, Mayor and and they are hereby authorized and empowered to appro-council of Baltimore priate annually for the "Baltimore Manual Labor School to approfor Indigent Boys," any sum or sums of money not exceeding the sum of fifteen hundred dollars per annum.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect Effective. from the date of its passage.
