

CHAPTER 197.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money for the support of the Co-operative Workers of Baltimore City.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sum of one thousand dollars a year for each of the years eighteen hundred and ninety-two, and eighteen hundred and ninety-three, be and the same is hereby appropriated to the Co-operative Workers of Baltimore City, for the support of their building known as Vacation Lodge, at Blue Ridge Summit, Maryland, and that the Treasurer of this State be and he is hereby directed on the warrant of the Comptroller to pay to the treasurer of the said Co-operative Workers of Baltimore City, the sum of one thousand dollars for each of the years aforesaid.

Appropriation to the Co-operative Workers of Baltimore City.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 198.

AN ACT to enable the mayor and city council of Baltimore to appropriate money for the relief of the Baltimore Manual Labor School for Indigent Boys.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the mayor and city council of Baltimore be, and they are hereby authorized and empowered to appropriate annually for the "Baltimore Manual Labor School for Indigent Boys," any sum or sums of money not exceeding the sum of fifteen hundred dollars per annum.

Mayor and council of Baltimore to appropriate.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
