SEC. 311 H. Nothing in this act contained shall be construed as relating to the sale of liquors and lager beer on Sunday, or to minors, or without license, or within local option or prohibition districts, or localities of said county; but proceedings for said violations of the law shall be hereafter, as heretofore, prosecuted under existing laws.

## CHAPTER 202.

AN ACT to regulate fishing with hook and line in the waters of Back River, Seneca Creek, Seneca River, Salt Petre River and Middle River and their tributaries in Baltimore County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That it shall be unlawful for any person to fish with hook and line from any boat or float of any kind in the waters of Back River, Seneca Creek, Seneca River, Salt Petre River and Middle River and their tributaries in Baltimore County from the first day of November to the first day of April in each and every year; and any person so fishing in said waters shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before any justice of the peace of the State of Maryland in and for Baltimore County of having violated the provisions of this section, shall pay a fine of not less than ten dollars, nor more than thirty dollars for each and every offence; one-third of said fine to be paid to the informer, one-third to the constable or other officer making the arrest and the balance to the treasurer of the Board of County School Commissioners of Baltimore County.
