CHAPTER 32.

AN ACT to add a new section to article thirteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Harford County," sub-title "Collectors," to follow section fifty-six, and to be numbered thirty-six A.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That a new section be added to article thirteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Harford County," sub-title "Collectors," to follow section fifty-six, to be numbered fifty-six A, and to read as follows: Harford County.

56 A. The County Commissioners of Harford County shall accept as security on the bond of any collector of taxes, any trust company in the State of Maryland that is authorized by law to become security on the bond of public officials; provided the said commissioners shall be satisfied that the security so offered is responsible for the amount of said bond. Security.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

CHAPTER 33.

AN ACT to ratify, confirm and approve, the act entitled, an act to authorize and enable the County Commissioners of Caroline County to aid the Delaware and Chesapeake Railway in the construction of the branch railroad authorized by chapter two hundred and sixty of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of eighteen hundred and eighty-six, by issuing the bonds of said county to the amount of sixty thousand dollars, for the purpose of raising money to be expended in such construction, and to levy a tax on the taxable property of said county for the payment of the interest and principal of said bonds as authorized by chapter three hundred and ninety of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of eighteen hundred and ninety.
