of Maryland passed at its present January session for the registration of voters in said respective wards of the city of Hagerstown, said registers may not have strictly complied with all the formalities required by said act; but for the convenience of affording the privilege of registration to all qualified voters applying therefor may have failed to observe sundry provisions thereof; and

WHEREAS, all irregularities, if any, made as aforesaid, Preamble. were committed without dishonest intent and in order to facilitate the operation and fulfill the spirit of said act of assembly; therefore,

Appoint-

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the appointments heretofore made by the Governor of Maryland of registers of voters for the respective wards of the City of Hagerstown be and the same are hereby made valid and legal, as fully and completely as though said appointments had been made in strict conformity with the provisions of chapter thirty-six of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland passed at its present January session, entitled an act to repeal sections one hundred and fifty-six, and one hundred and fifty-nine of article twenty-two of the Code of Public Local Laws entitled "Washington County," sub-title "Hagerstown," and to re-enact the following in lieu thereof in amending and revising the charter of Hagerstown, and in providing for the government thereof, and to add new and additional sections to article twenty-two of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Hagerstown."

And be it enacted, That the appointments heretofore made by the Governor of Maryland of the board of supervisors of elections for the City of Hagerstown be and supervisor, the same are hereby made valid and legal as fully and completely as though said appointments had been made in strict conformity with the provisions of chapter fifty-five of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland passed at its present January session, entitled "An act to repeal sections one hundred and sixty-one and one hundred and sixty-two of article twenty-two of the Code of Public Local Laws entitled 'Washington County,' sub-title 'Hagerstown,'" and to re-enact the following in lieu thereof in amending and revising the charter of Hagerstown and in providing for the government thereof, and to add new and additional sections to article twenty-two of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washingtown County," sub-title "Hagerstown."
