

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That the purpose and intent of this act is only to add to the number of justices of the peace as now provided by law, two justices of the peace, one at large from the second legislative district of Baltimore City and one at large from the third legislative district of Baltimore City, and that nothing contained in this act shall in any way affect the tenure of office of any justice of the peace heretofore appointed.

CHAPTER 224.

AN ACT to add two new sections to article one of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Allegany County," sub-title "County Commissioners," to follow inmediately after section thirty and to be designated as sections "thirty A," and "thirty B."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That two new sections be and the same are hereby added to article one of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Allegany County," sub-title "County Commissioners," to follow immediately after section twenty, and to be designated as sections "thirty A," and "thirty B," to read as follows :

Sections added.

30 A. At the general election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday of November, in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-three, there shall be elected five county commissioners for Allegany County, three of whom shall be elected for and serve the term of two years and two of whom shall be elected for and serve the term of four years; and thereafter on the expiration of the terms for which the said commissioners shall have been elected, there shall be elected respectively three county commissioners and two county commissioners for the term of four years to succeed the said commissioners whose terms shall thus have respectively expired, and the terms for which said commissioners shall thereafter be elected, shall be for the full term of four years; and said commissioners so elected shall severally receive for the services performed the same compensation as is now allowed by law.
