

Shall hold office. after the first Monday in November in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-one shall hold their office for two years from the time of their election. or until their successors qualify, and shall receive the same compensation as is now provided by law.

#### CHAPTER 225.

AN ACT to provide for the indexing of the Senate journals, the bound volumes of the Senate printed bills, and Senate documents in the office of the secretary of the Senate.

Provide index to Senate Journal. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the secretary of the Senate shall provide an index to the journal of the Senate of the present session of the General Assembly to be published and bound with the journal, after the close of the present session; and he shall also provide an index to the volume of Senate Printed Bills that are bound and placed in the State Library at the close of the session, and to any Senate documents that may be printed and bound in book form.

Duty of Secretary of Senate. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That it shall be the duty of the person who shall be the secretary of the Senate at each ensuing session of the General Assembly to make the indexes provided for in the first section of this act, to the Senate journals, the volumes of printed bills and senate documents of said ensuing sessions.

To receive amount appropriated. SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That for the making the indexes provided for in the first section of this act the secretary of the Senate of the present session of the General Assembly shall receive the amount appropriated in the general appropriation act for the current fiscal year for indexing the Senate journal and documents of this session, upon the certificate of the president of the Senate that such indexes have been properly made and completed, and at this and all ensuing sessions of the General Assembly a sum of money shall be appropriated, not to exceed three hundred dollars, among the legislative expenses for the next ensuing session to pay the secretary of the Senate for indexing the journal, the volume of printed bills and bound documents of the Senate; to be paid to said secretary upon the certificate of the president of the Senate that a proper and complete index has been made to the books herein specified.

Effective. SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
