

## CHAPTER 252.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Kent County to open a street or road through certain private property in the village of Still Pond.

**SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Kent County are hereby authorized and empowered to open a street or road through a part of the yard and garden of the late Annie E. Gale, in the village of Still Pond in said county, and through a part of the yard and garden of a tenant house on the lands of Robert G. Bowers in said county.

**SEC. 4.** *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 253.

AN ACT to require the clerk of the Circuit Court for Allegany County to re-record certain portions of the land records of said county.

**SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the clerk of the Circuit Court for Allegany County, be authorized and directed to re-record in a well-bound and suitable record book or books, such deeds, mortgages or other instruments, now of record in the clerk's office of said county, and which have in course of time, become nearly illegible, as shall in the opinion of the judge or judges of the Circuit Court for said county require to be re-recorded.

**SEC. 2.** *And be it enacted,* That all deeds, mortgages or other instruments when so re-recorded shall have the same validity and effect to all intent and purpose, as the original record of said instruments, now has or did have at the time of their first recording, and that copies of any such re-recorded instruments, made in accordance with section fifty-nine, article thirty-five, of the Code of Public General Laws, shall be evidenced and have the same effect as copies of the original record certified in accordance with said section fifty-nine.

**SEC. 3.** *And be it enacted,* That the said clerk shall be entitled to and receive, the same fees and compensation for
